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
There are many different types of Kindle devices available, as well as a Kindle app that can be used on other tablet devices (iPad, android, etc.). It is often easiest to do the following steps on a computer and then sync your device. If you are using a Kindle Fire, please use the instructions for tablet or smartphone users.

You will need:


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
1. Visit our website at www.ncrl.org. Click on “Books and More” in the menu, and then click on “OverDrive” (located under “Digital Media”).
2. On the top right side of the screen, click on “Sign in.” Sign in using your library card number and password (usually the last four digits of your phone #).




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
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1. Visit the Amazon.com website, and choose the “Manage Your Content and Devices” page from the “Your Account” drop-down menu. You will see a list of all the Kindle books on your account.
2. To the left of the title you wish to transfer, click “Actions” (icon with three dots), and choose “Download & transfer via USB.”
3. From the drop-down menu, select your Kindle, and then choose “Download.” Be sure you remember which folder you download your content file to. You will use this file to transfer content from your computer to your Kindle.
4. Connect your Kindle to your computer with the USB cable. Your Kindle’s screen will show that it is in USB mode. On Windows computers, your Kindle will appear in the “Computer” or “My Computer” folder. On Mac computers, your Kindle will appear on the desktop.
5. Open the Kindle folder, and then open the “documents” folder.
6. Locate the file you downloaded earlier, and then drag and drop it into the “documents” folder in the Kindle folder.
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2. Choose the “Manage Your Content and Devices” page from the “Your Account” drop-down menu. You will see a list of all the Kindle books on your account.
3. To the left of the title you wish to delete, click “Actions” (icon with three dots), and then “Delete.”
4. If you completed these steps using your computer, you will need to sync. Use the settings on your Kindle to connect the device to wireless internet. Click “Home” and then “Sync & Check for items.”
