The Cashmere Teen Poetry Slam returns on Thursday, Feb. 16 at the Cashmere Riverside Center.

The community is invited to support local teens and participate in the judging as 15 Cashmere students perform their original compositions to the theme “My Future Me.” The teens will be evaluated by a panel of judges — and votes cast by the audience.

The free, public event begins at 7 p.m. in the BSA Fireplace Room at the Cashmere Riverside Center.

Prizes will be awarded, including a grand prize of \$100.

This will be the third Teen Poetry Slam is organized by the Cashmere Public Library and Cashmere High School English Department, and is sponsored by Friends of the Cashmere Public Library and local businesses. The first two events were held in 2019 and 2020, but then the program went on hiatus due to the pandemic.


