FERRY COUNTY COMMISSIONERS APPOINT NEW NCW LIBRARIES BOARD MEMBER

Nancy Churchill, a resident of Republic, is the newest appointee to the NCW Libraries Board of Trustees.

Ms. Churchill was appointed by the Ferry County Commissioners to serve out the remaining six years of the term previously held by Katherine Meade, who had served on the board since 2017.

Ms. Churchill is a native of Tennessee and graduated from the University of Tennessee at Martin with a Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration. She brings a wide variety of career experiences to her role on the board. She has worked around the country as a systems engineer, a small business owner, and in various retail customer-facing positions. She currently works as a marketing consultant providing freelance digital marketing services and email marketing to clients locally and globally.

As a child, Ms. Churchill spent many happy hours in the public library system. During college, she worked at the library and became familiar with every aspect of the library from checkout, to the stacks and the media room. She has a lifetime love of public libraries and a great appreciation for how reading changes lives.

Ms. Churchill has been a resident of Ferry County since 2017 and is active in the community. She serves on the Planning Commission and as State Committeewoman for the Ferry County Republican Party. She writes a weekly column for the Ferry County View.
