Waterville Public Library to Pause Services during Move to New Building

2/24/2023 - The Waterville Public Library, a branch of NCW Libraries, is scheduled to move into a new location in April 2023.

To prepare for the move, Waterville Public Library will pause services beginning Saturday, March 11 at 2PM. Services in the new building are tentatively scheduled to resume in mid April, depending on construction timelines and other factors.

“A public library is a valuable community asset. I am thrilled that the town of Waterville has been able to purchase a building on Main Street that will allow the library to expand its services,” said Amy Larsen, Branch Librarian, Waterville Library.

Visitors to the current location will see some changes over the next few weeks as materials are being packed up.

Any materials on hold that have not been picked up from the Waterville Library by the closure date will be delivered via NCW Libraries' Mail Order Library service.

During the closure, the book drop will be closed. Patrons can keep materials until the library reopens or return them to any of NCW Libraries' 30 locations across North Central Washington.

All NCW Libraries card holders can place and pick up holds at any NCW Libraries location or opt to have materials mailed to their homes through the Mail Order Library service. The Mail Order Library service is free for NCW Library card holders. For more information visit ncwlibraries.org/waterville.

The Waterville Public Library is one branch of NCW Libraries, a public library district service Chelan, Douglas, Grant, Ferry, and Okanogan Counties through 30 library locations, 2 community bookmobiles, and a Mail Order Library service.
